EU-wide relevance of apprenticeships

- Over 10 million IVET students in EU
- 2.8 million students in combined work- and school-based systems (2015)
- 2 in 3 apprentices are hired directly following their training; 3 in 4 employed after 12 months
- Apprenticeship schemes are widespread in the EU and 27 Member States have commitments under the European Alliance for Apprenticeships






