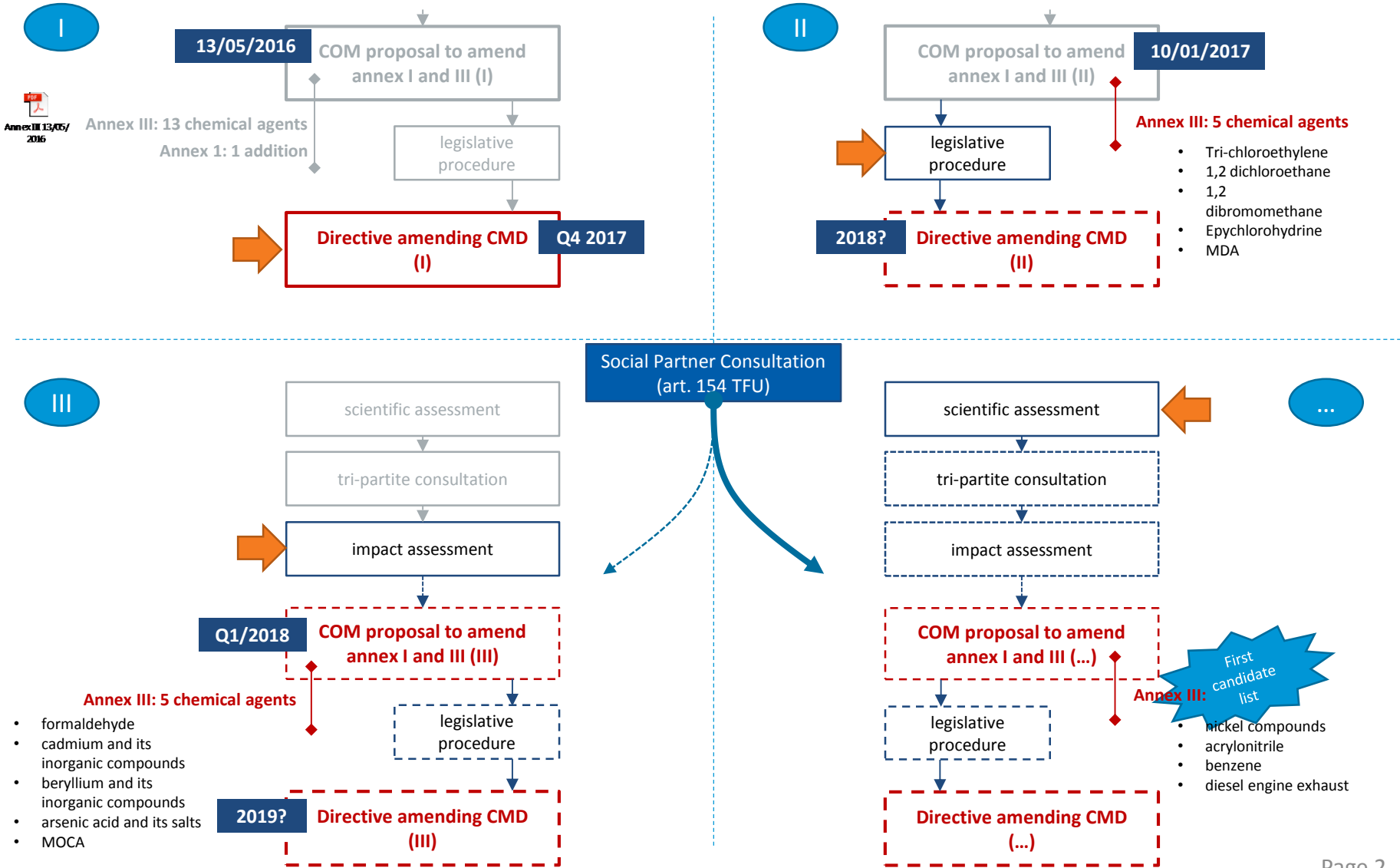

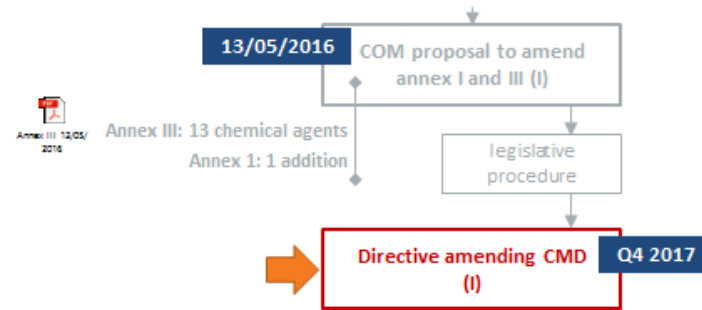

# Several revisions CMD running in parallel

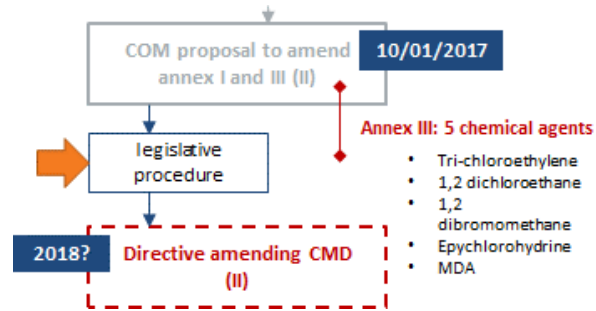


# Review CMD (I)



- Main outcomes
  - Setting occupational exposure limits for 13 chemical agents
    - COM proposal changed for RCS, hard wood dust and chromium VI
  - COM to assess impact of including reprotoxic substances in scope of CMD by mid 2019
  - Health surveillance: doctor/responsible authority to decide to continue health surveillance after exposure
- Formal adoption procedure closed by the end of 2017
- Member States have to 2 years to transpose directive

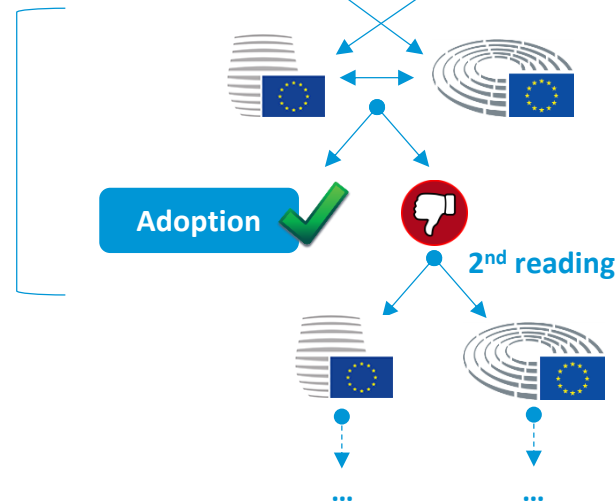
# Review CMD (II)



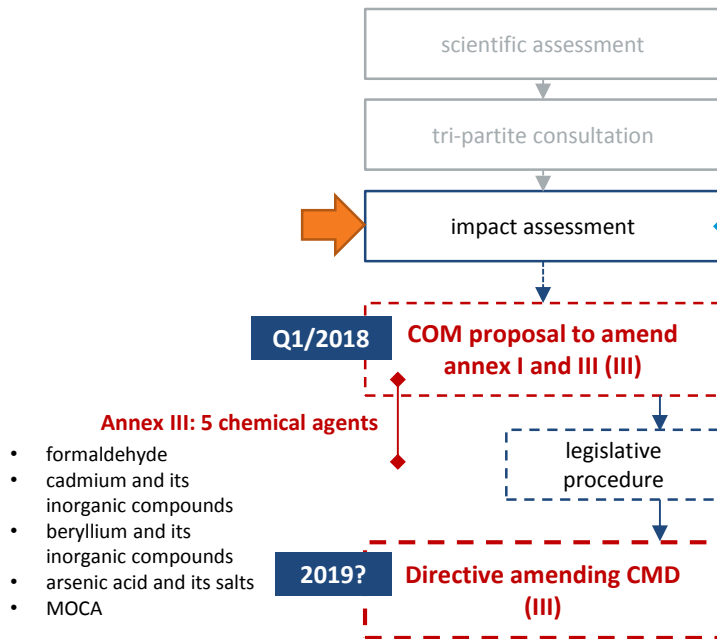
- Endorsement COM proposal

- Call to include diesel engine exhaust emissions
- Other amendments?
- Final position February 2018

Negotiations spring / summer 2018

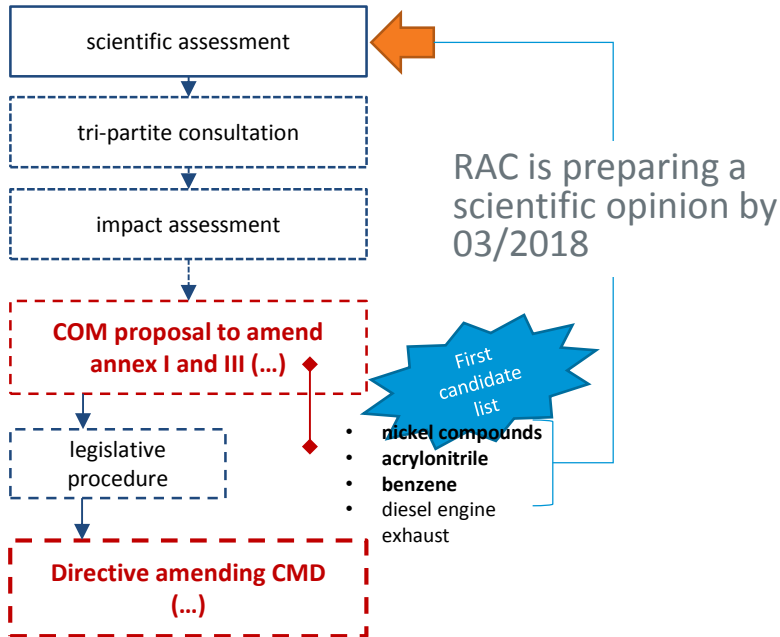


# Review CMD (III)



- Assessing impact of several options to set an occupational exposure limit for 5 chemical agents
- Timeline
  - Stakeholder consultation: 09/2017 -> 11/2017
  - Final report consultant: 02/2018
  - Final impact assessment: 03/2018

# Future reviews CMD (IV, V, VI, ...?)



## Social Partner Consultation (art. 154 TFU)

- Where do we want to go with the CMD?
  - No EU action
  - Guidance documents
  - Legislative action – setting EU wide binding OELs (annex III CMD)
- Cefic's – ECEG's view
  - support setting EU wide binding OELs
  - Retain current comprehensive approach
  - Develop transparent framework to prioritise substances to be included in annex III – including short & mid term vision
- 2 phases
  - 1st ended 09/2017
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> ending 22/12/2017
