## NOTE FOR THE ATTENTION OF THE HEADS OF DELEGATIONS AND HEADS OF COOPERATION OF THE OPSYS PILOT DELEGATIONS<sup>1</sup>

**Subject:** First OPSYS production release - Call for action

I am pleased to inform you that in my capacity of Chairman of the Project Steering Committee for OPSYS Track 1 – Results and Monitoring, I have given my approval to launch the first OPSYS release - allowing us to monitor and capture the results of our interventions<sup>2</sup> - in production. For the moment this capability applies to grants in direct management and to service contracts.

I invite you to share this message with your operational managers and implementing partners.

In practical terms, you should use this first OPSYS release:

- For <u>ongoing</u> interventions, to encode <u>actual results</u>. However, this applies only to interventions with an EU contribution below 750,000 EUR, as the ones above this threshold will be encoded through the results reporting exercise recently launched by the Director General (<u>Ares(2018)3440427</u>). All information captured by the results reporting exercise of this year will be imported into OPSYS for all future exercises;
- For <u>new</u> interventions, to encode <u>logframes</u> and <u>actual results</u> (by operational managers and implementing partners). Operational managers will be able to review them (i.e. approve, reject, or ask for modifications).

Please note that your reporting obligations for the 2018 reporting exercise remain unchanged.
