Registration

- Pre-registration completed (>2.6 million preregistrations submitted)
- Companies preparing for 30 Nov 2010 registration deadline
- 9000 substances expected to be registered
- SIEF awareness campaign
- Open issues under discussion
 - Legal
 - Practical

Substances of Very High Concern

- 1st candidate list published on 28 Oct 08 (15 chemicals)
- ECHA recommended inclusion of 7 of these substances to the Commission
- On-going: preparation of EC decision on Annex XIV. Comitology decision expected spring 2010
- 1st Sept. 09: Public consultation launched on 15 other substances

- Implementing legislation (Fees, BoA, Test methods): all adopted, Test methods Regulation 1st ATP

Classification & Labelling

 Classification and labelling is the first step to define the hazards of chemicals and thus to ensure that the substances are manufactured, used and disposed of safely



- CLP Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 entered into force on 20 January 2009
 - Implementation of agreed UN-wide system (GHS)
 - Transitional period 2010–15; both classification systems to be used
- Guidance published in August

ECHA Update

- Inauguration on 3 June 2008
- Tasks in:
 - Registration
 - Evaluation
 - Authorisation
 - Restrictions
 - C&L
 - Dissemination of information
- Staffing-up
 - currently ~350 staff + interim staff and contractors)
 - Staff numbers to grow by over 100 in 2010 to >450

ORGANISATION

- Management Board
- Executive Director
- Secretariat (currently staff of 350)
- Three Scientific Committees
- Forum on Enforcement
- Networks (Help Net, RCN, SON)
- Board of Appeal



Main current challenge

- Getting ready for crucial deadlines
 - 30 Nov 2010: First registration deadline
 - 3 January 2011: notifications for Classification and Labelling
 - Staff and IT systems, advice and assistance to industry
- Prepare for dossier evaluation
 - Major scientific task for ECHA (target for 2010: 600 evaluations started; compliance checks and testing proposals and 70 decisions taken)
 - Stringent deadlines for decisions (testing proposals by 1 Dec 2012, if received by 1 Dec 2010; >1000 tonnes p/a)


