The wide spread of the SARS-CoV-2 Coronavirus has led to a shortage of disinfectants in Cyprus.

In Cyprus, there is a limited number of hydrogen peroxide based products currently on the market and a sufficient supply cannot be guaranteed over a longer period of time.

Taking also into account the reopening of the tourism sector and the need to address the relevant higher risks, we expect a further grow of the demand for disinfectants for which shortage has been already notified.
