Brussels, 29 February 2012

Plenary outcome

- **RSPG adopted the Work Programme for 2012 and beyond, after public consultation, as a framework program linked to the challenges of the EU spectrum policy and starts the first Working Groups**
- **RSPG approved the final Opinion on the Review of Spectrum use after public consultation**
- **RSPG to approve the final Report on economic and social value of spectrum, within the joint BEREC-RSPG cooperation scope**
- **RSPG to approve the final Opinion on EU assistance in bilateral negotiations with third countries and between EU countries, after public consultation**
- **RSPG discussed the outcome of the recent World Radio Conference 2012 and the implication on EU spectrum policy and tabled a dedicated agenda point for the next Plenary in June**
