- A comparison tool between companies'own operators and european profiles








Companies web system use

Benefits for companies

Identify competencies :

A European competence profile can:

- serve as a referee/peretere/peretere competence management of operators for individual companies
- help companies to define competence profiles for their operators
- be linked to national certificates to give information about the value of certificates of EU countries

A European competence profile can:

- serve as a reference/standard for assessment of competencies of individual workers, whether acquired by formal, non formal or informal learning
- be used to identify the gap between required and acquired competencies
