WHY DO WE NEED A EUROPEAN LABOUR **AUTHORITY?**

- free movement of workers and the freedom to vide services depend on well-functioning crossder mobility.
 - *1ember States are responsible for enforcement of EU* egislation in fields of cross-border employment and ocial security coordination
- There is a need for a Authority to support cooperation and ensure the fair and effective enforcement of EU rules
