<u>COOPERATION EAC –</u> <u>EUROPEAN SOCIAL PARTNERS</u>

- **Joint declaration** (Oct. 2013): strengthened informal cooperation between Commissioner Vassiliou and the European social partners
- Action plan with priorities covering whole spectrum education and training
- Several technical meetings
- Positive assessment by EAC



ET 2020 STOCKTAKING

- No routine exercise
- Education Council of February 2014
 - Stocktaking should prepare the next Joint Report, with a more forward-looking focus, identifying key priority areas and concrete issues for future work
 - We should try to optimise the added value and effectiveness of ET 2020 and its underlying governance and working arrangements



INPUT IN ET 2020 STOCKTAKING

- ET 2020 National Reports
- Input by the senior officials: HLG, DGs
- Input by the European social partners
- Education, Training and Youth Forum
- Independent evaluation
- Variety of sector-specific input and studies



MAIN STEPS OF ET 2020 STOCKTAKING

- Autumn 2014: DGs discussion sectoral priorities
- Autumn 2014: Forum & European social partners provide input
- Autumn-Winter 2014-15: Education Committee briefed on various inputs
- Dec 2014: HLG first overall discussion
- March 2015: COM adopts draft Joint Report (tbc)
- May 2015: Council adopts Joint Report (tbc)



INCOMPLETE PRELIMINARY INDICATIONS

NEED FOR AN INTEGRATED FRAMEWORK

- Great emphasis during the consultations on the need for an effectively integrated strategic framework covering
 - Learning in all contexts (formal, non-formal, informal)
 - Learning at all levels



ET 2020 OVERALL DESIGN

 Strategic objectives and priority areas not logically and systematically connected to the indicators and benchmarks



ET 2020 STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

- MS & stakeholders follow cautious approach
- With indication of the need for a fine-tuning and updating of the existing objectives



FUTURE ET 2020 WORK PLAN

- More concrete, focused, operational, limited ...
- Identification of priority areas and concrete issues to be taken up – criteria:
 - common challenge?
 - added value of tackling at European level?
 - potential for sharing and learning in the area?
 - prospect of reaching a concrete outcome?



ET 2020 WORKING METHODS

- Recognition of importance of ET 2020 mutual learning
- Constructive criticism -- ET 2020 OMC could:
 - better showcase excellent practices
 - have more systematic, effective communication, valorisation and dissemination
 - offer a more systematic approach to mutual learning activities



ET 2020 GOVERNANCE

- Political steering: Council & EP could be involved in a more regular, systematic manner
- Link formal-informal governance: HLG-DGs-Education Committee
- Transparency: ET 2020 governance guide/chart
- Reporting: optimising needed
