Ex-post evaluation:

- New **five-yearly** exercise under the OSH Framework Directive 89/391/EEC (Article 17a).
- First exercise covering period 2007 to 2012.
- Previously evaluated directives individually.
- Part of Regulatory Fitness (REFIT) programme.
- The Commission will inform EP, Council, EESC, ACSH of the results of the evaluation and of initiatives to improve the operation of the regulatory framework.





Ex-post evaluation – main elements for final Commission report

- National implementation reports based on Commission Decision C(2011) 9200 that defines the structure and questionnaire to be followed by Member States (including social partners views).
- Independent study by an external consortium (COWI (lead), Milieu Ltd and IOM Consulting Ltd).
- Commission's own experience with Directives.





Ex-post evaluation – inclusive approach to engagement of stakeholders

- Advisory Committee for Safety and Health at Work (ACSH), principally via Working Party on Evaluation of OSH Directives (tri-partite approach: governmental experts together with employers' and workers' representative organisations).
- Senior Labour Inspectors Committee (SLIC)
- Social Dialogue Committee
- Inter-Service Steering Group (ISSG) with representatives from 13 Commission DGs, European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA) and European Agency for Improvement of Living and Working Conditions (Eurofound).





Current state of play and next steps

- ACSH Opinion on external study adopted at Plenary meeting of 24th September 2015.
- Preparation of Staff Working Document work ongoing
- Adoption of the SWD and informing Council, EP and others mid-2016
