


REACH in short (1)



- One system for new and existing chemicals.
 Focus on:
 - high volumes (as a proxy for potential risk)
 - greatest concern (substances & uses with highest risk)
- Shift of responsibilities: public authorities → industry



REACH in short (2)



REGISTRATION incl. pre-registration



All this to.....

- protect of the human health and the environment
- enhance
 - free circulation on the internal market
 - competitiveness and innovation
- promote alternative test methods




Scope of the regulation

⇒ REACH applies to the manufacturing, import, placing on the market and use of substances
 ⇒ On their own, in preparations, in articles


However, there are exemptions and reduced obligations



Information per substance



Registration (Timeline)



pre-registration – the following information to be submitted

- Substance identification: EINECS number, CAS number, Name
- Company and contact information
- Deadline for registration and tonnage band
- "Read across possibilities "
- Do you want to act as SIEF formation facilitator?



REACH: current status


- Implementing legislation
 4 additional regulations are now adopted
- Review of the REACH annexes nearly finished
- GHS CLP
 Publication in OJ expected by December 2008
- Guidances is almost completed http://reach.jrc.it/guidance_en.htm
- Communication activities on-going
- 1 June 1 December 2008: pre-registration



Pre-registration is closed

- ECHA received more than 2.2 mill. preregistrations + 6000 bulk files
- Pre-registration provisions available for companies that starts manufacturing or importing 1 tonne or more of a chemical substance after 1 December 2008, but not for companies with phase-in substances that failed to meet the pre-registration deadline





Next step: Pre-SIEF Formation

- 1. Pre-registration submitted by potential registrants
- List of substances is to be published beginning of 2009
- 3. Data holders are brought into the system
- Submitters of the same identifier are brought together (REACH-IT): "Pre-SIEF"



SIEF Formation

1. Potential registrants within Pre-SIEF must check whether their substances are the same

Agreement on the sameness: SIEF is 'born'



European Chemicals Agency: ECHA

- ECHA today:
 - ≅ 250 staff
 - Started to manage the registration and evaluation
 - First steps in authorisation
 - Guidance / IT tools
 - Helpdesk(s)
 - Committees + Forum established
 - Stakeholder involvement + consultations started
- ECHA in future:
 - Up to 450 staff
 - Will have an important role in authorisation and restriction






