Authors have the exclusive right to authorise/prohibit reproduction of their work

EXCEPT

- Reproduction on paper (photocopying)
- Reproduction on any medium for private use (private copying)
- Reproduction by libraries, schools, museum (non-commercial)

if **FAIR COMPENSATION** of the authors through national scheme:

- Hardware levy
- Operator levy
- Dual system

- → Different levy systems = obstacle to free movement of goods and services in the Internal Market
- → New ways of copying, new devices

What device can be subject to levy?

"... in principle all media, equipment, and devices capable of making copies ..."



- Typical customers of printing industry are rightholders
- Professional devices ≠ household devices
