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# Law requirement

- \* All public institutions must declare on their website
- \* their goals for the next year
- \* An evaluation of the work on last years goals.
- \* Every 3 years schools must evaluate the school's educational environment
  
- \* From 2010 all schools must submit their resource accounts on the school website (negotiated with school principals' association)

2. User satisfaction (next slide)
3. Student/teacher ratio
4. Workload of teachers
5. Teachers' competences
6. No. of new students
7. No. Of graduated students
8. Special focus areas
9. Student absence
10. Staff competence development
11. International activities
12. Pedagogical pilot projects
13. Total cost (filled in by Ministry)
14. Financial key figures (filled in)
15. Key expenditures (filled in)
16. Staff satisfaction (every 2-3 y)
17. Staff turnover
18. Staff absence (illness)

# Annual students' satisfaction surveys

- \* Two private firms have developed survey forms in dialogue with schools and offer data processing
- \* Standard questions are relevant but can be changed locally
- \* Not intended for evaluation of individual teachers but of class' teachers as a group
- \* Voluntary in 2010 and 2011, then mandatory
