## IFDM Recommendation 9 of 26-05-2016

## on the usage of the Referenced Message identifier in the ACDR reports

The Fisheries Control Experts Group – ERS (Electronic Recording and reporting System) and Data Management Working group,

## Taking into account that:

- (1) the current ACDR report correction practice of providing the reference to the previously accepted report creates administrative burden to MS;
- (2) there is only one report per type<sup>1</sup> and per reporting period; the reporting period start date and end date can serve as the business reference for system's needs;
- (3) the FLUX General Principles require the usage of Referenced Message ID information in case of a report correction or update, not if the report is submitted as new.

## Recommends:

- 1. that the first report of a certain type and of a certain period should always be submitted as new report, thus ActionType = 'C';
- 2. that the following reports of that type and period can be submitted again as new report, thus ActionType = 'C'; the Referenced Message ID can still be a part of the report XML structure, but it will not be checked;
- 3. to allow submitting the following report of that type and period as an update report (ActionType = 'U'); the Referenced Message ID shall be provided and it refers to the previously accepted report for that type and period (current business rules in force);
- 4. to apply the Recommendation as soon as the necessary adaptations are done in DG MARE<sup>2</sup>, but not later than 1 October 2016.
