

- manufacturing processes more sustainable.



Insurance firm Fukoku Mutual Life Insurance is making 34 employees redundant and replacing them with IBM's Watson Explorer AI






Polarisation on the labour market

Digital skills in numbers

- 44% or 169 million Europeans do not have basic digital skills. Of these 77 million people have no digital skills at all.
- Lack of interest and lack of digital skills top reasons to not get internet at home.
- 37% or 80 million in the labour force do not have basic digital skills. Of these 26 million have no digital skills at all
- ICT jobs now 3.5% of total employment
- Risk we might lack 100,000s of ICT specialists in 2020



What is the Digital Skills and Jobs Coalition?

- 1 of 10 actions in New Skills Agenda for Europe
- Network that brings together Member States, companies, social partners, non-profit organisations and education providers...
- Take action to tackle the lack of digital skills in Europe.
- Builds on the Grand Coalition for Jobs, the <u>eSkills for</u> <u>Jobs</u> campaign and <u>Education and Training 2020</u>.
- **Extends the scope:** beyond ICT sector to e.g. health care, farming, education, accounting, engineering and retail.
- Strong Member State involvement through digital skills strategies by mid-2017 – "Shared Concept"



Goals by 2020



- Train 1 million unemployed young people for digital jobs
- Support the upskilling and retraining of the workforce and in particular support small and medium enterprises (SMEs)
- Modernise education and training
- Reorient and make use of available **funds** to support digital skills
- Awareness-raising


