- Idea based on **Communication *New Skills for new Jobs*** and subject to the Commission restructuring Forum in December 2009
- In late 2009 the Commission published **18 sector-based studies** on emerging and future skill needs up to 2020
- There has been no study for the extractive industries sector
- Result of studies ask for closer cooperation on future skills needs between stakeholders on European level
- Outcomes of feasibility study ask for involvement of Social Partners and national skill councils (where existing)
