



**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF A NOTIFIED DRAFT MEASURE UNDER ARTICLE 7 OF
DIRECTIVE 2002/21/EC¹ AS AMENDED BY DIRECTIVE 2009/140/EC**

Case NL/2012/1299:

Wholesale broadband access (Market 5) and wholesale terminating segments of leased lines (Market 6) in the Netherlands

- 1) On 21 February 2012, the Commission registered a notification from the Dutch national regulatory authority, *Onafhankelijke Post en Telecommunicatie Autoriteit* (OPTA), concerning the third review of the market for wholesale broadband² access and for wholesale terminating segments of leased lines³ in the Netherlands.
- 2) By a letter of 4 May 2012, OPTA withdrew its notification on the abovementioned market.
- 3) Pursuant to point 19 of Recommendation 2008/850/EC⁴ the notified draft measure is removed from the register.
