e Household Record

The New Sample Household Record is made up of two clearly differentiated parts:

A first part made up of the 'Household composition table', which is a set of data on people, the result of asking the Person Reporting the dwelling about all the people who meet certain requirements, with the aim of writing down all the household members. They are questions organized so that no person is forgotten and that finally allow deciding whether or not the people listed are members of the household.

First, ask about ALL the people currently present in this dwelling and who consider it their habitual residence (taking into account that there is only one habitual residence), if possible starting with the person(s) responsible for the household. People present are classified as CASE = 1.

Once those of CASE= 1 have been noted, you should ask for ALL the people who consider this their habitual residence and who are currently absent. These people are classified as CASE= 2.

The second part is made up of a series of questions about the people who have been identified as members of the household in the previous 'Household composition table'.
