Budget headings & related calls for proposals

- Budget heading 04 03 01 08 (ex-04 03 03 01) Industrial relations and Social dialogue
 - Call for proposals **VP/2015/001** (Support for Social Dialogue)
 - Call for proposals VP/2015/004 (Improving expertise in the field of Industrial Relations)
- Budget heading 04 03 01 05 (ex-04 03 03 02) Information and training measures for workers' organisations
 - Call for proposals **VP/2015/002**
- Budget heading 04 03 01 06 (ex-04 03 03 03) Information, consultation and participation of representatives of undertakings
 - Call for proposals VP/2015/003





Overall objective: striving for increased added value and efficiency

- Strengthen distinction between calls
 - Split of former 01 (SD+IR) call
 - Clearer and more precise formulation of objectives, in particular for IR call (call 04)
 - TU-only projects under WO call (call 02)





- Stronger link with/contribution to SD/IR at EU level
 - SD (call 01): priority for joint projects
 - SD (call 01) : high priority for projects linked to SD committees' WPs (cross-industry and sectoral)
 - SD (call 01) and WO (call 02): stronger involvement of EU social partners r if project submitted by national/regional organisation, genuine involvement of EU SP as co-applicant or associated organisation
 - IR (call 04): priority for projects that contribute to EU IR analytical products (IRE report)





- Promote projects covering full "cycle" (including implementation and evaluation)
 Ionger duration, bigger budgets
 - Requested grant not less than EUR 108000
 - Up to 24 months (SD call: longer duration possible for implementation of SD outcomes)
 - Increased co-financing rates: all 90% (95% for negotiation/implementation of agreements)






- More explicit instructions in order to improve quality of proposals
- *Reducing administrative burden*






Calls for proposals IR/SD/WO – 2014 initial appropriations/awarded








Calls for proposals IR/SD, WO – Average grant








Call for proposals IR/SD – Success rate








Call for proposals WO – Success rate








Call for proposals WO – (Lead) beneficiaries

2014 calls for proposals – Additional observations

- *SD call: very high number of rejections on eligibility grounds (51%)*
 - Lack of involvement of ESP (48 cases)
 - WO application without involvement of employer organisation (14 cases)
- WO call: higher number of rejections on eligibility grounds (23%)
 - Lack of involvement of ESP (10 cases)





2014 calls for proposals – Additional observations

- SD and WO calls
 - If project submitted by national/regional organisation, genuine involvement of EU SP as co-applicant or associated organisation
 - But: involvement EU SP is not always genuine...
- *IR call: very high number of rejections on award criteria* (63%)





2014 calls for proposals – Conclusions



- Lower number of longer projects with larger budgets
- Concentration towards prime target group and projects linked with SD committees' work programmes





2015 calls for proposals

- No additional major changes
- Further clarifying objectives/targeted measures IR call
- Seeking further reduction of administrative burden

- Deadlines

- 1 deadline "Support for Social Dialogue" (VP/2015/001)
- 1 deadline "Information and training measures for workers' organisations" (VP/2015/002)
- 1 deadline "Improving expertise in the field of industrial relations" (VP/2015/004)
