Strong involvement of Social Partners

- EU Social Partners Cross-industry level (BUSINESSEUROPE, UAEPME, CEEP and ETUC)
 - part of the joint declaration with on-going projects on cost-effectiveness (employers) and on a quality framework on apprenticeships (trade unions)
- 5 joint pledges from EU Social partners at sectoral level:
 - Education (ETUCE, EFEE)
 - Chemical industry (IndustriAll, ECEG)
 - Construction (EFBWW, FIEC)
 - Commerce (UNI Europa, EuroCommerce)
 - Food & Drink (EFFAT, FoodDrinkEurope)
- 17 pledges form Social Partners at national level (almost all trade unions)



On-going activities

- 20 Guiding principles on work-based learning/Apprenticeships developed by the ET2020 Working Group on VET (published soon)
- Erasmus+ call on apprenticeships in SMEs launched on 15 October (Deadline: 15 January 2016)
- Launch of the European Pact for Youth on 17 November 2015:
 Business-led initiative on business-education partnerships
- EU social partners' projects on cost-effectiveness (employers) and on a quality framework on apprenticeships (trade unions)
- OECD study on cost-benefits of apprenticeship
- Country reviews on apprenticeships by Cedefop and the ILO



Next steps in 2016

- Launch of a study on EAFA progress monitoring
- EU-US workshop on apprenticeships (February)
- Launch of pilot project on long-term mobility for apprentices
- New ET2020 Working group on Teachers & Trainers in Workbased learning (including a mapping study)
- Forthcoming Commission initiative on Skills
- Implementation of new EURES regulation (including apprenticeships based on employment contract)
- European VET week to increase the attractiveness of VET (November/December 2016, tbc)
