REACH Review 2017



- Mandatory obligation in REACH and CLP Regulations to review every five years the functioning of REACH and CLP
 - Hence in 2017 the second review will take place
 - One year before, ECHA publishes its evaluation
 - Two years before, all Member States send in their evaluation

REACH Review 2017



- Upgraded to be part of the REFIT exercise
 - REFIT Evaluation inputs
 - Effectiveness
 - Efficiency
 - Relevance
 - Coherence
 - EU added value

REFIT



- In parallel with the REACH Review REFIT exercise
- Fitness Check on the most relevant chemicals legislation (excluding REACH)

- The last one started earlier but will end later
- According to the latest statements of the Commission we can expect the Commission communication and staff working documents:
 - End of 2017 for the REACH Review REFIT
 - End Q1 2018 for the most relevant chemicals legislation (excluding REACH)

REACH Review 2017



- Next to the mandatory contributions from ECHA and Member States
- Additional contributions take place
 - 17 Studies have been done or are running or just kicked off
 - A public consultation took place

Cefic contribution to the public consultation



- Some basic considerations
 - Despite 10 years of REACH in June 2017 still early day
 - The last deadline with more substances and much more SME's still has to come
 - Substance evaluation only started in 2012 and seen the time needed for higher tier testing the first round is not finished yet
 - For authorisation the first latest application date was in 2013
 - We learn quickly, but still in a learning phase

Cefic contribution to the public consultation



- REACH is functioning relatively well
 - Authorities indicate that quality was expected to be better
 - But huge exercise done by industry in time of economic crisis
- REACH delivers but there are clearly possibilities to reduce the burden for EU industry
 - What can be done more for SME's in view of the 2018 registration deadline?
 - How to make authorisation fit for purpose for smaller companies in Europe?
 - How to create the level playing field for EU manufacturers of articles?
