DIRECTIVE 2004/37/EC on the protection of workers from the risks related to exposure to carcinogens or mutagens at work

1st Revision of CMD: Directive 2017/2398


- Annex I: Work involving exposure to respirable crystalline silica dust generated by a work process
- Annex III: Binding Limit values: Respirable crystalline silica dust: 0.1 mg/m³
- New <u>Article 18a</u>
 Evaluation: The Commission(...) will evaluate the need to modify the limit value for respirable crystalline silica dust (5 years after implementation).

Social partners' agreements

Social Partners' agreements possibly concluded in the field of this Directive shall be listed on the website of the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA). That list shall be regularly updated.

Stefan Olsson (DG EMPL): NEPSI will be the first on the list and will be the benchmark for any future SDA on this list in the future



Presentation of the two-year Grant (2019-2021)

NEPSI 5-year Roadmap agreed by the NEPSI Council early 2018

Overall title: in the next 5 years NEPSI will support the implementation on the ground of the CMD and will prepare for the evaluation of the BOEL (binding occupational exposure limit).

Specific actions will be launched towards extension of the scope, special attention to SMEs and new workers
