

PROSPECT – simplification of the Calls for Proposals

The System Owner (Unit B6) has the pleasure to present PROSPECT, a new system that renders the Calls for Proposals (CfP) cycle paperless by integrating the entire process into one online system.

PROSPECT in a few lines...

PROSPECT automates and facilitates the tasks of internal users and civil society by providing online access to the calls for proposals: no more encoding, archiving of applications, printing or signing of letters and sending documents by post, to name just a few examples.

Reduced workload

PROSPECT will significantly reduce the workload for our colleagues working on approximately 250 Calls for Proposals launched in both Headquarters and Delegations every year which generated more than 26.000 paper applications.

Better data quality

The number of manual operations will diminish and consequently the new system will significantly reduce the risk of encoding mistakes. This will ensure a higher data quality level for CfP evaluations and for the annual reporting exercise.

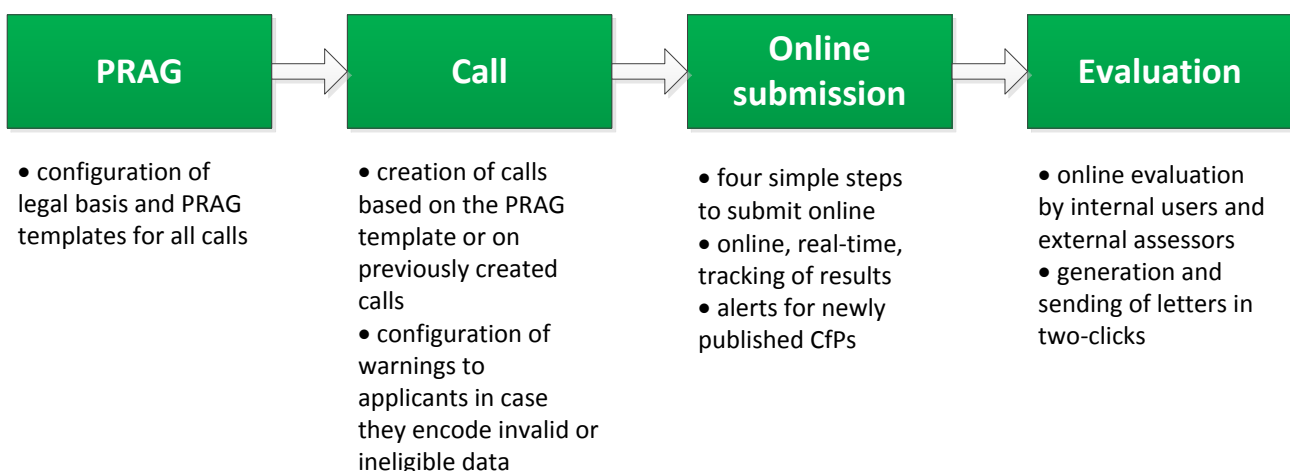
Better service to the civil society

Additionally, PROSPECT will deliver better services to civil society organisations participating in CfPs. Applications will be submitted online and applicants will follow-up the progress of the evaluation and receive their results online.

They will be notified on the latest information concerning them by an automated system. Notifications on "recently published" calls will be also possible!

One process, one system, online.

The schema below illustrates the four modules of the system:

Currently, the project is in a pilot phase: on 19.11.2013 DEVCO launched a successful pilot Call managed at HQ, which is now at 'Concept note evaluation' stage.

PROSPECT will be fully available to colleagues in Headquarters and Delegations via the DEVCO homepage as of 2015.
