



Hair and Beauty SSDC Work Programme 2015-2016

The Social Dialogue Committee approved its Work Programme 2015-2016 and included some indicative timing:

- 1. Analysis of the structure of the sector (undeclared work, employment and working conditions facts and figures) January 2015–December 2016
- Assessment of training and skills/competences acquisition in the sector (Formalisation of European hairdressing certificate, Euroskills, access to the profession, SWOT analysis of training and apprenticeship schemes) – January 2016–December 2016
- 3. Implementation of the European framework agreement January 2015–December 2016 (related social dialogue projects)
- 4. Information on transnational trade agreement (TTIP) January 2015-December 2016

The Social Dialogue Committee agreed to seek cooperation on its work programme themes with external stakeholders such as Cosmetics Europe and others.
