The surveillance system records and centralizes all EU trade data (import and exports) directly from the national customs authorities on a daily basis. According to Art.55(2) of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/2447, the customs authorities shall provide the Commission at least once a week with data on customs declarations for the goods that have been made subject to surveillance at release for free circulation or at export.
