





Where are we now?

- Breakdown (level 1)
 - Production of life performance
 - Independent artistic creation
 - Arts mediation, education, leisure and therapy
 - Heritage (museum, archives and libraries)
 - Sport and active leisure
 - Amusement and recreation parks
 - Gambling and betting
 - Support of public activities



Breakdown (level 2)

- Production of life performance
 - Developing an organisational artistic vision
 - The development of the overall artistic vision of an organisation
 - Creation of a performance
 - Developing the content, format and shape of a production
 - Technical creation of a performance
 - Developing and manufacturing the physical environment for a live performance. Including all occupations that are mainly active in the preparation rather then the performance.
 - Execution of performance
 - Executing a live performance or event
 - Coordinating performance or event
 - Coordinating the creation, development and run of a series of performances or events.





Breakdown (level 2)

- Independent artistic creation
 - Writers
 - Creators of written, textual, artistic content. The content can stand on it's own or be used as base for an artistic work in live performance or audiovisual arts.
 - Composers
 - Fine arts
 - Applied arts
 - Specialised design activity
 - Trans media artist





Common descriptions

- Arts mediation, education, leisure and therapy
 - Arts mediators and educators
 - Socio artistic workers
 - Arts leisure
 - Art therapist





Common descriptions

- Support of public activities
 - General management
 - Infrastructure and logistics
 - Public relations
 - Administration, finance and control




