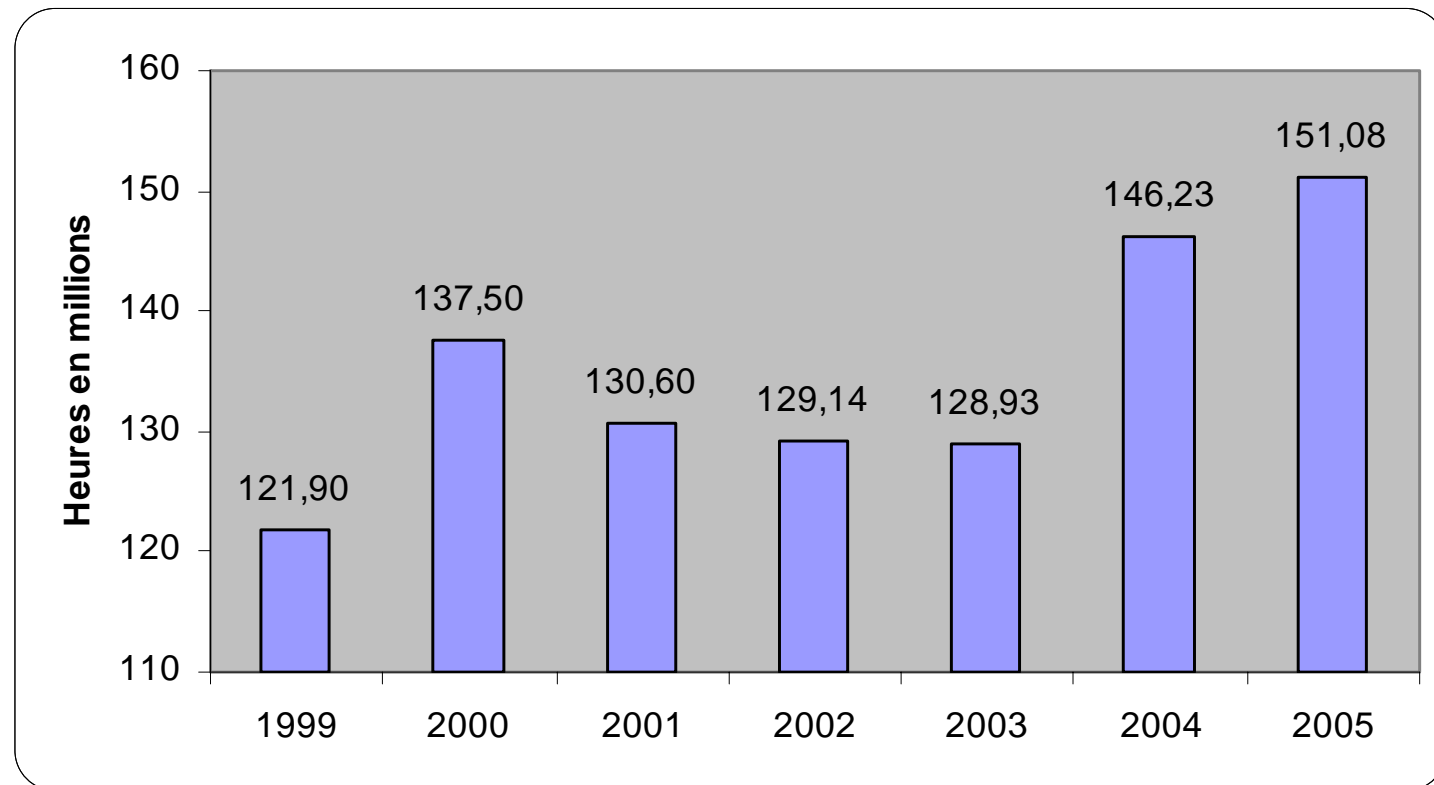
About Prévention et Intérim

- Board : comprises both temporary work agency and trade union representatives

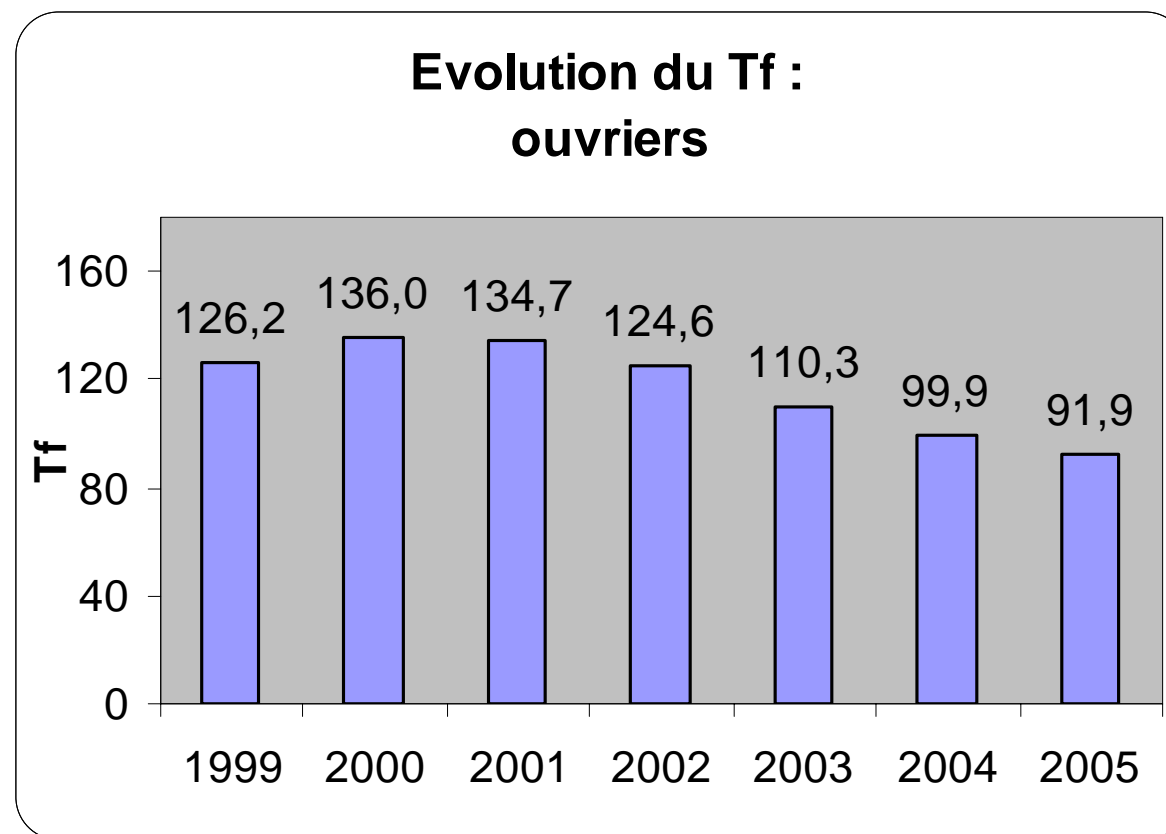
Temporary agency workers and accidents (2005)

- 356,000 temporary agency workers
- 9,992 labour accidents
- 187,786 days lost
- 7 mortal accidents
- 800 accidents with permanent incapacity
- Degree of frequency : 65.9
- Real degree of gravity : 1.25
- Global degree of gravity : 3.74

Evolution of the number of hours of exposure to risks (millions)

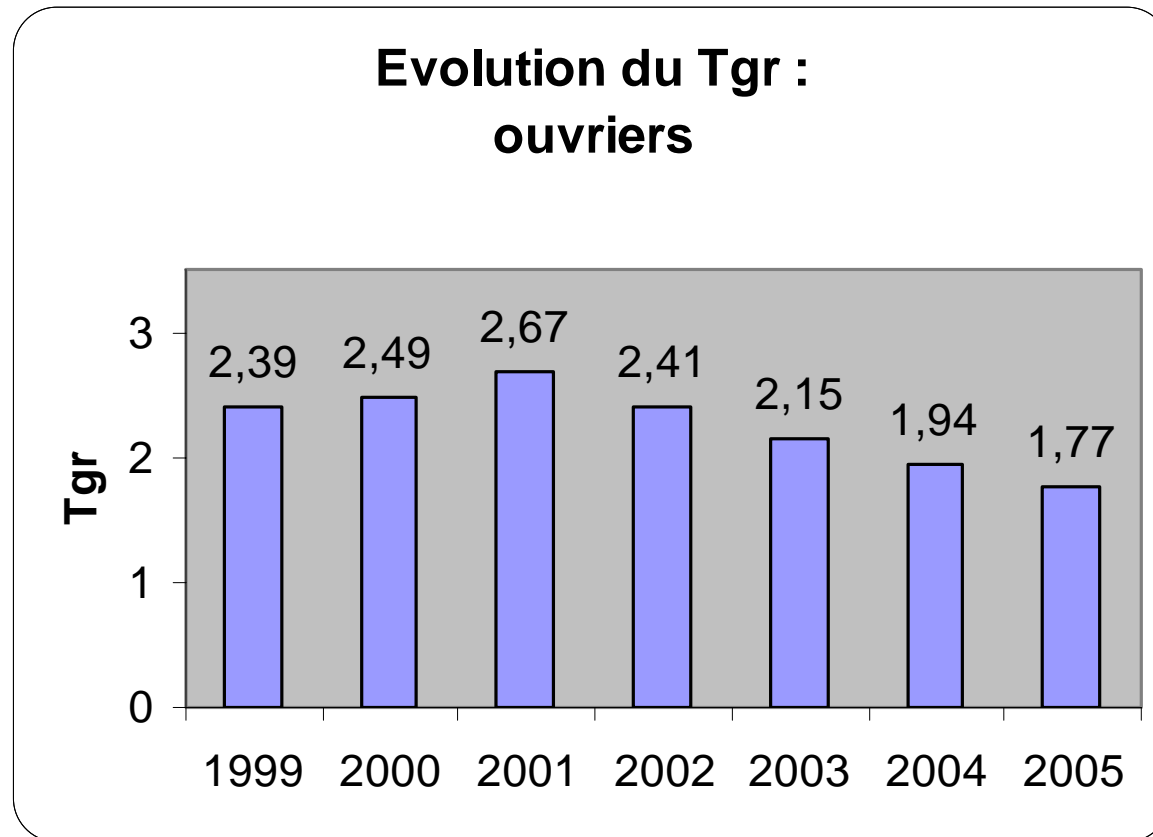


Evolution of the degree of frequency

<i>Form of the accident</i>	<i>%</i>
Fall of objects	7,8
Fall	14,5
Contact with a moving object	26.9
Pinching between objects	12,7
Effort, wrong movement while handling goods without motive power	11,3

Material agents

	Temp.	All
Materials, objects, products, machine or vehicle components	21,4%	14,1%
Hand tools, not powered	10,0%	8,1%
Surfaces at ground level	5,0%	7,9%
Mechanical hand tools - for cutting, separating (including scissors, shears, secateurs)	3,8%	2,0%
Stairs, ladders	3,0%	3,6%
Mobile handling devices, handling trucks (powered or not) - barrows, pallet trucks, etc.	2,4%	1,3%

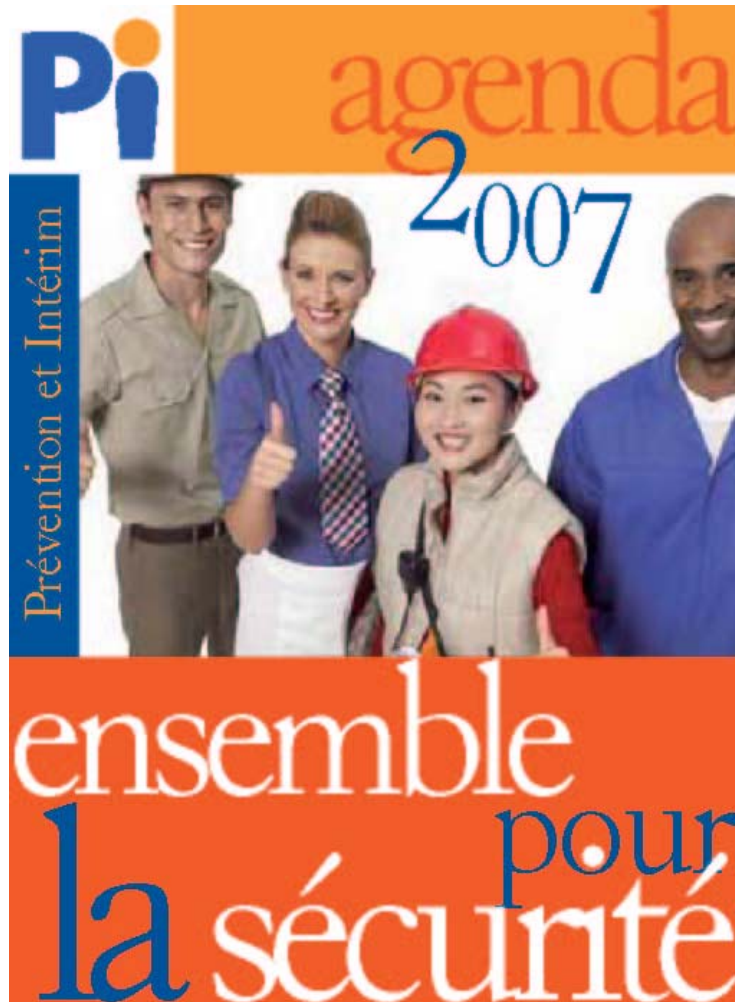
Temporary agency worker's profile



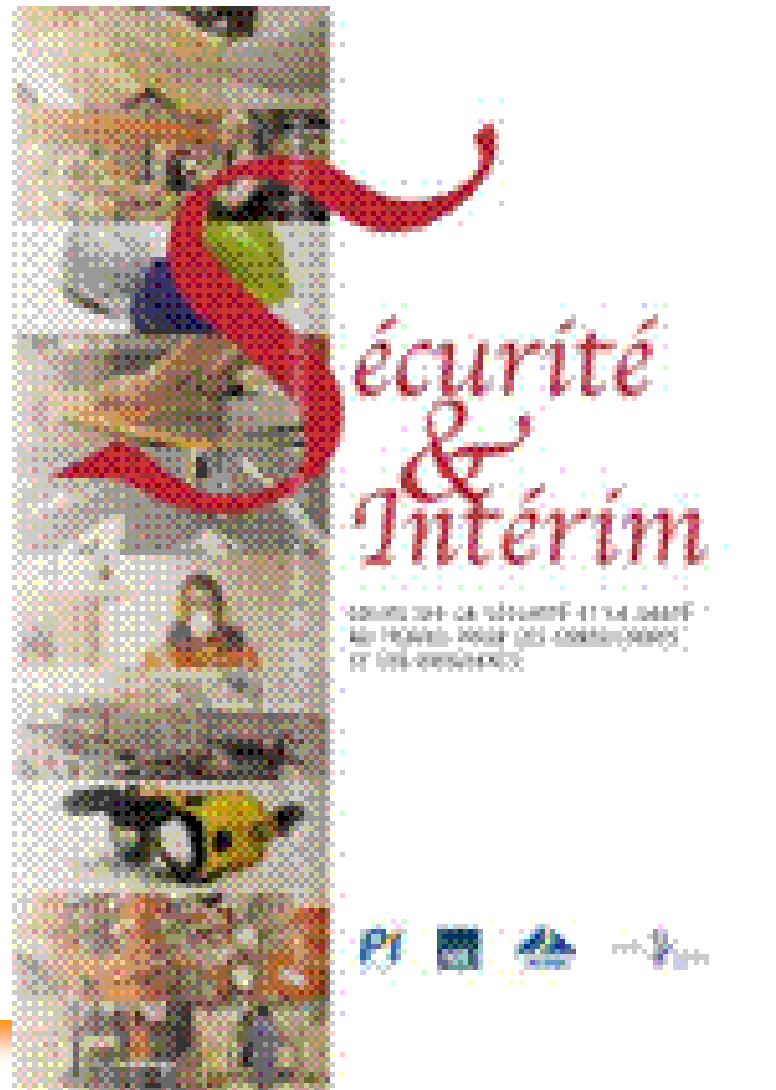
