

# Public Procurement Directives State of play on the implementation



#### **New Public Procurement Directives**

- Adopted on 26 February 2014
- Directive 2014/23/EU on Concession contracts
- Directive 2014/24/EU on Public Procurement
- Directive 2014/25/EU on procurement by entities operating in the water, energy, transport and postal services sectors ("utilities" Directive)
- Transposition deadline: 18 April 2016



## State of play on 9 March 2017

- Transposition completed:
  - For all three Directives, <u>14</u> Member States:
     CZ, DK, DE, EL, FR, IT, CY, HU, MT, NL, PL, RO, SK, UK
  - For Directives 2014/24/EU and 2014/25/EU, 4 Member States: BG, IE, HR, SI
- Transposition not completed :
  - For the Concessions Directive, <u>4</u> Member States:
     BG, IE, HR, SI
  - For all three Directives, <u>10</u> Member States:
     BE, EE, ES, LV, LT, LU, AT, PT, FI, SE



## **State of play**

- Non-communication infringement procedures:
  - Letters of formal notice sent on 26 May 2016
  - Reasoned opinions sent on 9 December 2016
- Next steps?
  - Still defaulting Member States: EU Court of Justice financial sanctions possible (Article 260(3) TFEU)
  - Other Member States: compliance check of adopted transposition measures
