(b) WG 2 on highly automated and connected vehicles

The mid-term recommendations/conclusions for 2020 systems presented to Sherpas on 18 November 2016, have been finalized by WG2/PT1 on 13 December 2016 session and by WG2 on 8 February 2017. Participants will be asked to endorse this first set of finalized conclusions/recommendations. Participants are invited to send substantial comments, if any, in writing by 16 February 2017. Sherpas may also wish to discuss about the next steps for 2030 systems and expected deliverables.

The sherpas will also receive an update on the progress made by PT2. A draft report, is being prepared by PT2 and is available on CIRCABC (PT2 section). Participants are invited to review the PT2 report to check that the work of PT2 goes in the right direction.

(c) WG 3 on global competitiveness

The sherpas will receive an update on the progress made by PT1 and PT2. A draft progress report is available on CIRCABC (WG3 section), along with two other documents: 1.) preliminary draft recommendations, which still require further WG3 discussion and serve merely to indicate the sense of direction, and 2.) the list of open issues. Participants are invited to send comments in writing by 16 February 2017.

Sherpas may wish to exchange views on the format of the final report and on the expected deliverables and give instructions to the working groups.
