- Autumn-Winter 2009: awareness campaign, workshops, training, invitation chains, online system update
- 15 January 15 February 2010: Reporting of sites
- February/mid-April 2010: Quality check of the reporting process by national and EU federations
- 22 June 2010: NEPSI Council

2010 Targets



- 1. Involving more sites
- 2. Having more reported sites
- 3. Improving KPIs for:
 - Risk assessment
 - Health surveillance for silicosis
 - Training
