1. <u>Seminar in Budapest: agenda, interpretation, speakers and chairs, social events</u> <u>and practical organisation</u>

Social partners' representatives discuss about the possibility to invite government representatives and on whether they would participate in a separated working group or not. It is envisaged that interpretation is provided in English, German, Czech, Slovak, Slovenian and Hungarian. The possibility to allocate interpretation accommodating the situation of each working group will be discussed on the spot. The participation of a representative from the Commission is foreseen; in case it is not possible for the Commission representative to attend, a neutral presentation will take place as it was done in Tallin, this time delivered by Bianca Busuioc (BB) instead of Anita Debaere (AD).

2. <u>Seminar in Krakow</u>

The seminar will take place on 10-12 May. Jerry Gorzynski (JG) reports on the preparation of the seminar, the main concern being the attendance of government representatives, as most of the targeted attendants will be participating in the other Warsaw meeting in May, organised by the audiovisual social dialogue committee.

3. <u>Visits</u>

Johannes Studinger (JS) reports that several dates in February are being considered for the visits, although it has not been decided yet whether those will take place during the first, second or third week of February. The issue will be discussed and agreed upon at a later stage.
