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

→ One common language for education and labour market in Europe







2. Preliminary results Online Consultation

- Stakeholders identified for 16 sectors + some sectors HEAL. Targeted three main actors:
 - ✓ European umbrella organisations,
 - ✓ National and regional sectoral organisations
 - Other networks: social partners, public and private employment services
- Contact with the identified organisation to:
 - \checkmark explain the purpose of the online consultation
 - to motivate them to contact domain experts to participate in the OCP
- Bilateral meetings with European organisations.

Two main observations:


•Experts collected feedback from their member organisations or consortium partners before feeding it into the online platform.

• The majority of experts belong to professional associations and training and education institutions.








Experts by country

- The experts registered for the OCP come from all over Europe. Some countries like Belgium, Spain or Hungary have a very strong number of experts registered
- Overall, there is a very wide geographical coverage and balance.
- From each European Member State at least 3 users registered for the online consultation.





Education sector

- → 106 active experts
- → 25 Member States with active stakeholders
- → 75,2% of Occupations reviwed

Main comments:

- Suggestions on adding more skills or occupations
- Comments on the relationships between occupations and skills

4. The qualifications pillar in ESCO

- Collecting existing data on qualifications
- Two approaches: direct and indirect inclusion
