Hazards Identification



Keyword message: Danger. Hazard Statement: Harmful if swallowed. Causes skin irritation. Causes serious eye damage. May cause drowsiness or dizziness. Precautionary Statements (Prevention): Wear protective gloves / clothing / and means of protection for the eyes / face. Precautionary Statements (reaction): IF ON SKIN (or hair): Wash with soap and water. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. If there are contact lenses, remove them if they are easy. Continue rinsing. Precautionary Statements (Storage): Store locked up. Precautionary Statements (disposal): Dispose of contents / container to hazardous or special waste collection point.

First Aid Measures

Description of first aid measures: Remove contaminated clothing. If inhaled: If difficulties occur after vapor or aerosol inhalation (aerosol), remove to fresh air and seek medical attention. After contact with skin: Rinse thoroughly with soap and water. If symptoms persist, seek medical advice. In case of contact with eyes: Immediately wash affected eyes for at least 15 minutes under running water with eyelids held open, consult an eye specialist. If swallowed: Immediately rinse mouth and then drink plenty of water. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention.

Firefighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media: Spray water, foam resistant to alcohols, dry powder, carbon dioxide, dry sand. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture: Carbon monoxide, hydrogen cyanide / hydrocyanic acid, nitrogen oxides. The substances / groups of substances mentioned can be released in case of fire.

Personal protective equipment



Personal protective equipment: Respiratory protection: Wear respiratory protection if ventilation is inadequate. Particle filter with medium efficiency for solid and liquid particles (eg. EN 143 or 149, Type P2 or FFP2). Hand protection: Suitable materials also with prolonged, direct contact (Recommended: Protective index 6, corresponding > 480 minutes of permeation time according to EN 374). Eye protection: Safety glasses with side-shields (frame goggles) (EN 166). Body protection: Normal work clothes and shoes. General safety and hygiene measures: Required Wearing of closed work clothing additionally the stated personal protective equipment. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not breathe vapor / spray. When using do not eat, drink or smoke. Hands and / or face should be washed before breaks and at the end of the shift. At the end of the shift the skin should be cleaned and apply skin care agents.





