## Legal background

### **European Works Council Directive**

Council Directive 94/45/EC of 22 September 1994 on the establishment of a European Works Council ... in Community-scale undertakings and groups of undertakings for the purposes of informing and consulting employees

- companies with > 1000 employees
- > 150 employees in ≥ 2 EUMember States
- workers' representatives from all countries where undertaking / group has subsidiaries
- > 1 annual meeting with central management
- select committee


### Information / consultation

#### Items for information / consultation:

- structure, economic and financial situation of the undertaking / group
- probable development of business and of production and sales
- situation and probable trend of employment
- investments
- substantial changes concerning organization, introduction of new working methods or production processes
- transfers of production, mergers, cut-backs or closures of undertakings, establishments or important parts thereof, and collective redundancies
- lacktriangleright on the basis of a report drawn up by central management
- ► on which an opinion may be delivered at the end of the meeting or within a reasonable time

## **European Works Councils**

- > 2000 companies covered by EWC Directive with 16 million workers ≈ 10% of all workers in the European Union
- > 800 EWCs set up
  - ± 10 million workers are actually represented in an EWC
- ≈ 100 EWCs in EFFAT sectors (food and hospitality/tourism)
