SOCIAL DIALOGUE **2005-2006 WORK PROGRAMME**

UNI-Europa and Euro-CIETT have agreed on the following work programme to be implemented in the framework of the sectoral social dialogue in 2005/2006.

1. Survey on the Regulation of Agency Work in the EU 25 and Candidate Countries (carried out by the Dublin Foundation in collaboration with Uni-Europa and Euro-CIETT). Results of the study will be presented by the Dublin Foundation in November/December 2005.
2. Study on measures enacted by the EU-25 and candidate countries, aimed at integrating disadvantaged categories of workers in the labour market through temporary agency work, as well as measures enacted to tackle the problem of undeclared work. Date to be fixed.
3. Discussion on measures to attract more people – and especially young unemployed persons - in the labour market via temporary agency work, within the framework of the Lisbon agenda – Date to be fixed.
4. Organisation of round tables as a pilot project with social partners in a limited number of new Member States and future member states e.g. Poland, Czech Republic. Following an evaluation of the results achieved by these round tables, this programme could be expanded to include further countries. The first 2 should be organised in 2006.
5. Open discussion on life-long learning and work-related stress, with a view to reaching a joint Euro-CIETT/Uni-Europa position – Date to be fixed.
6. Study and discussion on the way agency work can improve cross-border work mobility within the EU (including measurement of size and effects of cross border activities in the sector) – Date to be fixed.
