Public Procurement

- following the implementation of the new EU Public Procurement Directive
- further promotion of the EFFAT-FoodServiceEurope "Guide to the economically most advantageous offer in contract catering" at national and EU level, including contacts with mayors of various European cities
- joint initiatives with the social partners in cleaning and private security for the responsible awarding of contracts, e.g. awareness raising of EU, national, regional and local awarding authorities: joint letters to EU institutions, mayors of big cities, etc.

- monitoring of EU initiatives on qualification and training relevant for the sector, e.g. ESCO
- Fight against obesity

- Health and safety at work
 - following the new EU Strategy on Health and safety at work for 2013-2020
 - monitoring of legislative initiative to adopt a Directive on work-related musculoskeletal disorders (MSD)
