Progress



EU acts in force

- Regulation (EU) No 1143/2014 on the prevention and management of the introduction and spread of IAS
- Implementing Reg. (EU) **2016/145** adopting the format of the document serving as evidence for the permit issued by the competent authorities
- Implementing Reg. (EU) **2016/1141** adopting a list of invasive alien species of Union concern

- Commission and Member States may propose IAS
- Scientific Forum checks scientific robustness of information
 - Committee checks IAS for compliance criteria listing
 - Result:
 - First list (entered into force on 3 August 2016): 37 species
 - First update: in preparation
