Pilots - Aim

- > Test the tool (software)
- > Test the content management system
- Test the guides intended for the developers
- > Assess the needs in terms of training, help-desk,...
- > Test the diffusion model
- > Gather the proposals, comments, ... made by the organisations involved in the pilots.



Macro deadlines

- > Mid April: welcome package ready in EN, FR, NL
- End April/beginning May: First meeting with the pilots (PPTs presentations, presentation of the work plan, importance of involving the key people from the beginning, ...)
- ➤ End September- October: content is ready in the template and is uploaded by EU-OSHA onto the CMS
- ➤ End September: Second (middle) meeting companies (end users) are invited to check the sectorial tool drafted by the developers – in this occasion we introduce the CMS
- December: Third (last) meeting to discuss/assess the process, challenges, difficulties, quality of the documentation, needs to be met,
 - December: final sectorial tools are ready.
