

Purpose and scope

- Announced by the EU strategy on automated and connected mobility adopted on 17 May 2018
- Main goals of the guidelines:
 - Promote new technologies
 - Harmonize the practice on Article 20 of Directive 2007/46/EC
 - Ensure fair competition and transparency
- Focus on SAE levels 3-4





Procedure

- Harmonized documentation to be provided by the manufacturer in Annex I.
- Apply to the whole vehicle: Clear identification of compliant systems and not compliant ones.
 Interaction to be identified as well
- Guidelines are the basis for safety assesment
- Possibility to use EU or UN draft: Set the clock procedure.
- Possiblity to limit in time and in number the derogation based on the risk assesment.
- Transparency of the process/basis for approval in the Commission decision



Automated vehicles: Main requirements

Manual driver driver

- -Shall not cause accident
- -respect trafic rules
- -Allow interaction with other road users

Activation/ deactivation

Takeover request

Minimum risk manoeuvre Automated driving: System

- -Shall not cause accident

- -Is able to detect its limits for activation and minimum risk

Safety assesment and tests

- Generic method
- Design based on hazard and risk assesment
- Shall cover all the risks: New method needed



 Type approval authorities to audit the safety concept and run targeted tests
