

4.19 Segment Group 15 - (CDV): CDV - Code Value

4.19.1 Purpose

The segment contains a particular metadata code/value for a non-time dimension.

4.19.2 Segment Rules

It is the trigger segment for the Group 15, and must be present if the group is used.

4.19.5 Data Element Rules

9900 - Code Value

This is the particular code/value of metadata from the metadata set. The information should be considered as a language-less information.

As an example, the sequence number may be used to indicate the "Reporting Port" information, at the third place of the data set. Code Value would then be set to the UN-LOCODE of the reporting port.

9868 - Code Name

4513 - Maintenance Operation, Coded
