

4.1 UNA - Service String Advice

4.1.1 Purpose

This segment is used to define the characters selected for use as delimiters and indicators in the rest of the interchange.

4.1.2 Segment Rules

The Service String Advice must appear immediately before the Interchange Header (UNB) segment and begin with the upper case characters UNA immediately followed by the six characters selected by the sender to indicate, in sequence, the following functions:

- component data element separator;
- data element separator;
- decimal notation;
- release indicator;
- segment terminator.
